COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Deputy Mayor Randell reported that the committee met on May 12, 2021. Items of discussion were HR issues, budget and new shed for Public Works.

Deputy Mayor Randell declared being in a conflict of interest on the following motion and left the chambers.

WORKS & PLANNING

Councillor Brake reported that the Committee of the whole met on May 10, 2021 and discussed animal regulations and gave update on tenders.

RECREATION & COMMUNITY SERVICES

Councillor Anthony reported that the committee did not meet, however he did have discussions with the Recreation Director regarding activities at Pasadena Place and was informed that the after school program enrollment is up. A \$12,000 grant has been received from the Park & Play Program and there has been no update on the beach signage. Councillor Anthony inquired about the boat launch and was informed by the CAO, Brian Hudson that they are still waiting on quotes for concrete work. Councillor Anthony advised they are seeking information for a FM transmitter.

CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REPORT

The COA reported that the Tipping Drive tender release date is May 27, 2021. He informed council that the civil engineering workterm student has completed his term and all the GIS is fully up to date.
